This two-part series (which concludes tomorrow) follows Trevor McDonald and a team of experts as they investigate substantive rumours that infamous serial killers Fred and Rose West were behind even more murders than their 12 recorded victims. Forensic psychologist Donna Youngs (right) is joined by former DCI Colin Sutton and author Howard Sounes to tackle new leads and dramatic new evidence that could lead them to further burial sites. What they uncover means that this case is far from closed.

Finals week has arrived, and the five remaining celebrities have to keep their cool as they face their last challenges – including, tomorrow, the daunting Chef's Table, hosted by Tom Kerridge.
